	6.	Be bona fide with real and continuing business activities and ownership interests which are not created merely for the purpose of meeting the objectives of the LBCE Program.		
	7.	Be economically independent, perform commercially useful functions, and have a customer base.		
	8.	Valid professional license(s) or permit(s); e.g., architect, contractor, engineer, or motor carrier.		
	9. Small Local Business Enterprise (SLBE) and Very Small Local Business Enterprise (VLSBE) only: Internal Revenue Service (IRS) forms for each of the past three (3) years:
